Licensees of Acute Hospital Service, Ambulatory Surgical Centre Service, Assisted Reproduction Service, Blood Banking Service, Clinical Laboratory Service, Community Hospital Service, Contingency Care Service Licensees, Cord Blood Banking Service, Emergency Transport Service, Human Tissue Banking Service, Medical Transport Service, Nuclear Medicine Service, Outpatient Dental Service, Outpatient Medical Service, Outpatient Renal Dialysis Service and Radiological Service (“**Phase 1 and 2 Licensees**”)

LICENCE CONDITIONS FOR PHASE 1 AND 2 LICENSEES LICENSED UNDER THE HEALTHCARE SERVICES ACT 2020 (“HCSA”)

Following the issuance of the MOH Circular 89/2023 titled “Notice of Proposed Draft Modifications to Licence Conditions for Licensees Licensed under the Healthcare Services Act (HCSA) 2020” dated 18 Dec 2023, the Director-General of Health shall modify the conditions of your licence granted under the HCSA (“Licence”) by imposing one or more sets of the following appended conditions for your Licence (“**Licence Conditions**”). Please refer to **Annex A** for the Licence Conditions applicable to the licensable healthcare services (“**Services**”) you are providing. These Licence Conditions will take effect from the date of issuance.

2 As clarified in MOH Circular 89/2023, the amendments of the Licence Conditions are editorial in nature and serve to clarify the application or otherwise, of these Licence Conditions to Nursing Home Service Licensees whose licences have transited from the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act to HCSA on 18 December 2023. However, there are no changes in your obligations under the respective Licence Conditions previously imposed on 26 June 2023 via MOH Circular No. 39/2023 and/or 19 July 2023 via MOH Circular No. 47/2023.

3 These Licence Conditions will apply to all persons which have been licensed under the HCSA to provide the abovementioned services, and are intended to provide further clarity on the requirements to ensure the safe and effective provision of Services by P1 and P2 licensees, including any specified services provided as part of

the Service. All other conditions of your Licence that have been imposed before the date of this notification shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect (unless superseded), and these Licence Conditions shall be read and construed with the requirements stipulated in the HCSA and its Regulations [including but not limited to the Healthcare Services (General) Regulations 2021, the Healthcare Services (Advertisement) Regulations 2021] and the relevant Service Regulation(s).

4 A breach of the Licence Conditions may result in regulatory actions being taken against licensees under section 20 of the HCSA, including but not limited to —

- (a) suspension or revocation of the licensee's Licence;
- (b) shortening the term of the licensee's Licence;
- (c) a direction requiring the licensee to rectify the contravention, or prevent a recurrence of the contravention; and/or
- (d) a direction requiring the licensee to pay a financial penalty.

¹ Licence Conditions for Serious Reportable Events are applicable only to the following selected licensees of outpatient medical service (OMS):

- (a) OMS approved to provide any of the following specified services: (i) blood transfusion service, (ii) proton beam therapy, and (iii) radiation oncology and radiation therapy;
- (b) OMS provided as a service, only to students enrolled in a primary school or secondary school;
- (c) OMS provided as a service at a polyclinic; and
- (d) OMS provided as a service at a specialist outpatient clinic, where the licensee is a cluster HQ or its subsidiary.
